Thankfully, over the thirteen years the small elevator has been in use we have had hardly any problems with its operation. Everyone seems to quickly learn how to use, and have been mindful of others. For those who are new to its use and procedure, please note the following.

1. When leaving the elevator, please be sure **the gate is COMPLETELY PUSHED SHUT**. Gently push near the top to make sure contact with terminal is made (you should hear a little click). If the gate is not closed the person on the other floor waiting to use it will not be able to *call* it. Don’t forget that others who need it rely on you to close the gate.
2. Please limit use to not more than two or three persons at a time and just for those who are unable or have difficulty making the stairs.
3. Please remember that it is not a rapid-moving car and it usually takes some time for the people who use it to get in and out because of age or difficulty walking, so patience is required. Thank you.
