Returning to Mass in time of COVID-19

Please note the following rules that will apply at least for now, and kindly cooperate with them so that working together, all will feel safe, and we can speed up the day we can get back to normal. Get the latest information on our parish website www.saintanthonywoonsocket.org

1. The elderly, and those with underlying health conditions are asked to follow the most up to date health regulations and may remain at home. Bishop Tobin has extended the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass until further notice.
2. **Hand hygiene:** All are encouraged carry with them their own disinfecting wipes for use as needed. Please sanitize your hands prior to entering church.
3. A **mask** covering mouth and nose must be worn at all times.
4. A **Distance** of at least six feet from others must be maintained, with the exception of members of one’s own household.
5. **Singing is limited** to the organist/cantor to avoid increased dispersion of moisture particles. Hymnals are temporarily removed.
6. Maintain social distancing while in line to **receive Holy Communion**. Lower your mask before reaching the priest. Communion may be received in the hand or on the tongue. If fearful of receiving, there is always the option of not remaining in the pew.
7. **The Sign of Peace** remains suspended. Before and following Mass avoid unnecessary personal contact with anyone.
8. **The sick must stay home.** Anyone who has symptoms of any sickness (even mild symptoms) may not attend the public celebration of Mass.
