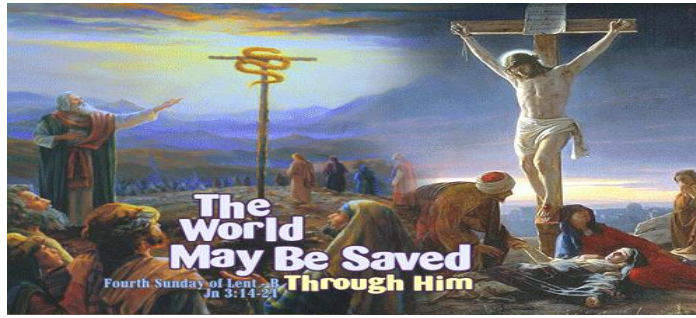

Rhode Island Civic Chorale & Orchestra
