BOILER GOOD NEWS!

Well, this week the HVAC people made an Apollo 13 effort to find a way of sparing us the cost of a new boiler at this time – and came up with a solution. It involved welding a new section into place where the steam pipe from the boiler is connected to and feeds into the church basement heating system (as the whole boiler was not severely compromised). The welding job was successful but we still need for the piping and connections to be reinstalled. Therefore, at this point it looks like we might get another few years use out of the present boiler. We'll see. Nevertheless, these repairs will not be cheap, but thank God, we will not have the major expense first anticipated. The present boiler was installed in 1994 and ran over \$30,000 plus the cost of asbestos removal. Our Annual Collection is beginning soon and hopefully that will help us meet whatever costs are involved. In a few weeks I will give the annual parish financial report, promote the Annual Collection, and hopefully by then, we will have a nice warm church.
