 What else could go wrong in 2020? Our church boiler has gone kaput. Upon an attempt to repair water leakage, we learned that the overall deterioration of the boiler is advanced to the point of being irreparable. This of course presents us with a major expense and the urgency of replacing the boiler before the cold weather sets in. We will begin seeking bids on a new one immediately. I would expect it to cost in the neighborhood of \$30,000.

I will be consulting with the parish finance council and the diocesan fiscal office to come up with viable options for financing or paying for the new boiler. We should avoid if possible taking on any more debt. We do have our Annual Collection beginning soon that usually raises about \$10,000, and hopefully that along with available funds in checkbook, as well as special donations, will get us through. I will be updating you as we go along, and also asking for your help in whatever way you can. In the coming weeks I will give the annual parish financial report and promote the Annual Collection.

On a happy note I am pleased to say we are just \$1500 from our parish goal of \$18,900 in the Catholic Charity Appeal which ends soon. If you plan to give please do so soon. Thank you to all who were so generous. I truly appreciate your continuing support and generosity. May God specially bless you. *-- Msgr. Simeone*
